

The Pardon of George Wilson

Sunne-

George Wilson was a thief. He and a friend committed a robbery in Pennsylvania in 1929. They were captured, tried, and sentenced to death in 1930. His friend was executed on schedule, but George had influential friends who pleaded for his life; and they convinced President Andrew Jackson to spare his life with a pardon.

The surprising part of this story is that George Wilson refused the pardon. He could have been set free, but he refused to accept it. Others could not believe Wilson was not willing to be pardoned, and they tried to force the pardon on him. He was taken back to court, but he still refused it. The case went all the way to the Supreme Court. It was determined that even though a pardon was offered, the court could not give the benefit of the pardon unless the pardon was accepted. A pardon can be accepted or rejected by the person it is offered to.

We have all sinned, and we are all under a death sentence. Christ offers us a pardon from our sins and an opportunity to live, but He will not force anyone to accept His offer. It is offered freely, but the recipient has to accept His offer for the pardon to be in effect. To refuse the pardon Christ offers means certain death.

How do we accept the pardon Christ offers? Through obeying His commands. We need to willingly receive His word by believing that He is the Son of God, repent of our sins, confess our faith in Him, be buried with Him in baptism washing away our sins, and live a faithful life.

The offer is free, but it will not be valid unless we accept it and follow these steps. If we accept His pardon, we have the hope of life with Him in Heaven.

How about you -- are you someone who will reject the offer of a pardon, or will you accept the pardon Jesus offers?
