

Daily Bible Reading

- Until I come, give attention to the **public reading of Scripture**, to exhortation and teaching. ([1 Timothy 4:13](#), NASB95)
- Therefore **the Law** has become our **tutor to lead us to Christ**, so that we may be justified by faith. ([Galatians 3:24](#), NASB95)
- Now these were **more noble-minded** than those in Thessalonica, for they received the word with great eagerness, **examining the Scriptures daily** to see whether these things were so. ([Acts 17:11](#), NASB95)

- Philip ran up and heard him **reading Isaiah the prophet**, and said, “Do you understand what you are reading?” ([Acts 8:30](#), NASB95)
- Then Philip opened his mouth, and **beginning from this Scripture he preached Jesus to him**. ([Acts 8:35](#), NASB95)
- When they had set a day for Paul, they came to him at his lodging in large numbers; and he was explaining to them by solemnly testifying about the kingdom of God and trying to persuade them concerning Jesus, from both **the Law of Moses and from the Prophets**, from morning until evening. ([Acts 28:23](#), NASB95)
- Then beginning with **Moses and ¹with all the prophets**, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures. ([Luke 24:27](#), NASB95)


