1) God spoke the world into existence (Psalm 33:6, 9). Genesis repeatedly says, “God said...and there was...” (Genesis 1:3, 6, 9, 11, 14-18, 20-21, 24-27). God commanded the world and its inhabitants to appear, and they did.

2) God created humans in His image (Genesis 1:26-27). We can think rationally, exercise free will, and desire morality and justice. Though we often fall short as image-bearers, we are elevated above the rest of creation (Psalm 8).

3) God called His creation very good (Genesis 1:31). Sin, not God's original work, brought corruption into the world. Creation shows God's goodness and His provision for people to enjoy what He has made (1 Timothy 6:17).

4) Creation points to God's glory (Psalm 19:1-6). The heavens do not merely declare that God exists; they declare His glory. The stars did not hang themselves. Natural revelation should lead us to seek God in His special revelation—the Bible (Psalm 19:7-14).

5) The Creator rules over nations

(Isaiah 40:9-31). God measured the waters in His hand and weighed the mountains in scales (Isaiah 40:12). Nations should remember that the God who made them can judge wickedness (Psalm 9:17).

6) Jesus created the world (John 1:1-3; Colossians 1:15-17; Hebrews 1:1-2). Jesus did not begin in Bethlehem. He pre-existed His incarnation and is co-equal with the Father. Our Creator was killed by His creation so He could save the world.

7) The Holy Spirit was involved in creation (Genesis 1:2; Psalm 104:30). The Spirit, like the Father and Son, is eternal and active in creation.

9) Those who deny creation are without excuse (Romans 1:18-20). God's power and nature are clearly seen in the world He made. Humanity often suppresses this truth to serve the creature rather than the Creator (Romans 1:25).

10) God sustains—and will judge—creation (Hebrews 1:3; 2 Peter 3:10-13). He holds all things together, and one day He will destroy this world, and we will inherit the new (Revelation 21:1-5). The most important creation is the new creation in Christ (2 Corinthians 5:17). Only those in Him will endure eternally.
